Young Woman's Bursary Guidelines & Application Form 2019

Guidelines and Eligibility

- Applicant must be a female 24 years of age or under.
- Applicant must be a citizen, permanent resident or legal refugee of Canada.
- Applicant must be from or living in the Greater Quebec City region and holding a local residential address.
- Applicant must be registered to enter, or currently enrolled in, a full-time undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate university degree program. One-year certificate or diploma programs at a university level may also be considered. An accredited technical school may be considered, depending on program choice. Accredited correspondence schools may also be considered, but in this instance, applicant must submit a confirmation of graduation by December of the year of application, to receive the award.
- If a candidate is selected for the final round, she will be required to answer a question by writing a short essay in English prior to a same day interview in English with the selection committee.
- Completed application must clearly demonstrate financial need and past academic performance.
- Applicant must supply two recommendations from supervisors with whom they have worked.
- Applicant will also be judged in terms of potential to succeed, motivation and community involvement.

Details regarding submitting your application

- Completed applications must be received by the Citadel Foundation no later than midnight March 1, 2019.
- Applications, either incomplete or late, will not be reviewed by the Bursary Committee.
- Please refer to the checklist to ensure application is complete.
- For 2019, applicants must submit ONE (1) email to kpoulin@jhparkers.net at the Citadel Foundation. This email must contain all the required documents in Adobe Acrobat PDF format. Applicants may submit the PDF documents as separate attachments in the email **or** as one zip file **or** as a compendium of all required documents summarized in one PDF document. The following must be included in the email in order to be considered: application form; personal essay; a minimum of two letters of reference; proof of acceptance; unofficial transcripts and Curriculum vitae. Personal signature is required. Print off completed document to sign and then scan.
- Each email is confidential.
- The subject line of each email will read "QCWC Bursary- YW-NAMEOFAPPLICANT"*(your name)*.
